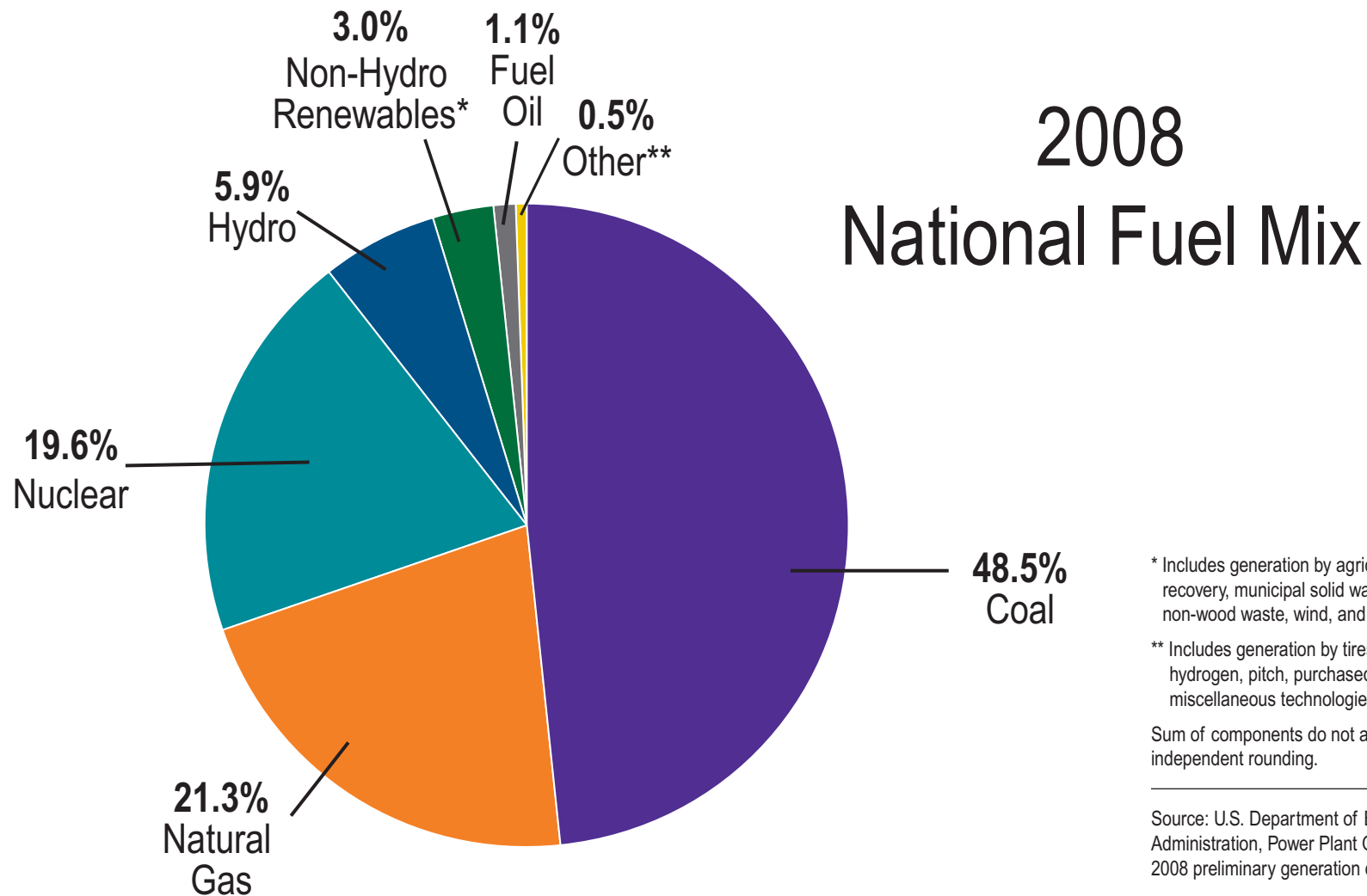


# Electric Companies Use a Diverse Mix Of Fuels to Generate Electricity
